Qualifications and Agreement

The Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Program is a part of Eagan's July 4th Funfest; a nonprofit organization run by a volunteer Board of Directors who plan and organize an annual event.

The Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Program and the Board of Directors set forth all rules and regulations.

As a candidate in the Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Program the following rules and regulations shall apply.

Eligibility Requirements

Miss Eagan Queen Candidates must be 17 (by 07/01/2010) to 23 years old and must be entering their senior year of high school and/or pursuing a secondary education. Contestants cannot be married during their candidacy or year of reign. Candidates must be sponsored by a local business (application fee paid for by the sponsor); the application fee is \$300.00 payable to The Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Program. This application fee is non-refundable unless the coronation is cancelled. The director can provide a list of potential sponsors but it is ultimately the candidates' responsibility to find a sponsor.

Attendance Requirements

Attendance is required at all pre-coronation activities; a schedule will be provided to each candidate. An excused absence must be approved in writing by the program director only. If chosen as Miss Eagan or a part of the Royal family (Princess) she agrees to the attendance policy set in the Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Program contract for the year of her reign.

Candidate Binder Requirements

Candidate must put together a 3 ring binder for judges with a photo of candidate on outside along with her name & division, the contents should include:

- Part One – Candidate Resume (2 page maximum)
 - Please include the following info in resume form:
 - Name
 - Name of School & Grade in the fall
 - Future Educational & Career Plans
 - What famous person would you like to have lunch with, and why?
 - If you had two hours of free time, how would you spend it?

- What is one thing no one knows about you (or important to you) that you would like everyone to know?
- Part Two – Two letters of recommendation from teacher, counselor, etc.
- Part Three – Last two years of official school transcripts.
- Part Four – Achievements / Special Honors & Awards / Volunteer Activities (this can include, but not limited to: certificates, letters from volunteer activity, lists of achievements, etc.)
- Part Five – Talents and Hobbies
- Part Six – One page essay about what you think is the role of Miss Eagan Queen.

Please Note:

- * **This is a part of the judging so please take your time and make it your own.**
- * **The only photo included in this binder should be on the outside of the binder.**
- * **The candidate binder will be returned after the coronation.**

Judging

The candidates are judged in the following 5 categories:

- **Individual Judges Interview** – Each judge will have the opportunity to sit with each candidate to get to know the candidate better as well as ask some general questions pertaining to your candidate application and your candidate binder.
- **Candidate Binder** – Six part “candidate resume” that the judges will critique, they will take into account the time and effort the candidate spent on the binder as well as the professional nature of the binder.
- **Education & Grades** – The Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Program promotes dedication to education and expects all participants to maintain an acceptable grade point average.
- **Poise & Personality** – The way in which a candidate conducts herself with others during events as well as outside of the Program. Reflects sound qualities of mind and character, shows confidence. Ability to socialize with people of all ages and positions – is genuine and enthusiastic.
- **Onstage Presence & Onstage Question** – the way in which the candidate presents herself onstage; posture, mannerisms & confidence. Answering the onstage question with honesty, in a genuine way and with confidence.

The judges’ decisions are final and judges’ scores will not be available for distribution.

Becoming a Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador requires an extensive time commitment; it is advisable that the candidate seriously considers whether or not she would be devote the required time to the Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Program.

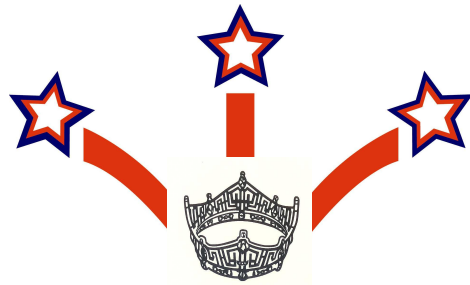

AQUATENNIAL ADDENDUM:

If candidate is chosen as the 2010 Miss Eagan Queen she will be given the opportunity to participate in the Minneapolis Aquatennial *Queen of the Lakes Program*. This program is a weeklong commitment including but not limited to: participation in multiple rounds of interviews, public appearances, Torchlight Parade and the Queen of the Lakes Coronation. If the Miss Eagan candidate is chosen as Queen of the Lakes or one of the Princesses she will agree to an exclusive contract with the Aquatennial Ambassadors Organization and travel throughout the state and nation representing the Minneapolis Aquatennial.

The Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Program will sponsor the Miss Eagan Queen candidate at Aquatennial. Miss Eagan's entry fee will be provided. She will be given assistance in selecting the proper clothing attire. The Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Director must approve all attire prior to use during Aquatennial week.

If the Miss Eagan Queen does not accept the nomination to the Aquatennial *Queen of the Lakes Program* it may be offered to one of her Princesses at the discretion of the Miss Eagan Funfest Ambassador Director.
